The resource person of the occasion was **Dr. Abhilash.** R, an Assistant Professor in the PG Department of Zoology, Christian College, Chengannoor, Alappuzha. About 77 participants including 55 students, and teachers from various disciplines of our College participated in the session.

Dr. Divya R., the seminar coordinator and Head of the Department of Zoology, S.N. College, Punalur, welcomed the online gathering. **Dr. Santhosh R,** HoD, Department of Physical Education and IQAC Coordinator of our College, addressed the gathering and conveyed his well wishes for the webinar.

Dr. Abhilash's talk dealt upon the importance of maintaining Public Health and Hygiene, which turned out as a very informative, short awareness session to the students and it was conducted at Seminar Hall of our College on 18th November, 2021. 


