Green Initiatives

Education on Environment and Sustainability is part of the contemporary curriculum to create awareness among students towards the need to preserve nature and develop a sustainable environment.

The institution conducts environmental audit annually to enhance environment friendly practices for managing liquid waste, solid waste, E waste, bio-medical waste etc and thereby ensuring clean and green environment.

Paperless Office Communication is encouraged among the teachers and the office staff. Electronic forms are promoted to reduce the paper usage. Social media platforms, emails etc are used for circulation and communication of information. The general announcements are done through the public address system.

The campus green cover is maintained annually with suitable plants species that can neutralize the carbon emissions in the campus premises. The trees in the campus are identified with their botanical names. Restricted entry of vehicles inside the campus and the car pooling system adopted by the staff ensures reduced emission of carbon dioxide in the area.

The college has taken initiatives to implement segregation of solid waste and hand over plastic waste for recycling and safe disposal instead of the unhealthy practice of burning it or dumping it in public places or water bodies. Biogas plants have been installed in the campus to convert the food waste generated into biogas. College has taken special safety measures in laboratory and also for the disposal of chemical waste in proper scientific way. College has installed incineration unit in the campus for hygiene and proper sanitation.

The use of plastic is strictly restricted in the campus. Students are advised to use no-plastic materials wherever possible, which avoids accumulation of plastic carry bags in the campus.

LED bulbs are used in the newly constructed buildings and some of the incandescent and fluorescent tube lights are replaced with LED bulbs. Majority of the class rooms, laboratories, administrative blocks, computer centers, libraries, seminar halls and staff rooms are provided

With LED lighting system which are supposed to be energy efficient.
